




During the past year the teaching program of the Department of Tropical Health was strengthened by the addition of new staff members and the introduction of new courses in "Tuberculosis Control" and in "Research Methods" for diploma students. Dr. Azar submitted for publication the results of this interesting study on rectal infection with Schistosoma hematobium in South Africa and Drs. Schwabe and Schinazi have continued their work on host-parasite relationships in echinococcosis. In conjunction with Dr. Asmar of the School of Agriculture, the epidemiologic survey on leptospirosis was continued as was that on systemic mycoses being undertaken by Drs. Daoud and Schwabe. Again this year departmental research benefited from financial support from the United States Public Health Service and Charles Pfizer and Company.

The Lebanese and the Nepali sanitarians with the laboratory technicians were kept to have their field training in the university.

Another thing that is ommitted this year is that we do not have any pictures for the summer field training. This was not possible to obtain in time to include in the Yearbook.


